FOR HIGH SCHOOL APPLICANTS: Choose one question from group A and one from Group B.

GROUP A:

1. How has your involvement at St. Mark enriched your life?
2. How has your St. Mark education (worship services, Sundays school, VBS, confirmation) enriched your life?
3. How have your St. Mark education and membership influenced the decisions you make when you face peer pressure?

Group B:

1. In what ways has God's Word been powerful in your life? How has it changed the way you think, feel, act, and talk?
2. In your own life and that of your family, what experiences have called for the most courage and faith? How did you respond at the time? If you had it to do over again, would your response be different? If so, how?

FOR POST HIGH SCHOOL APPLICANTS: Choose one question from group A and one from group B.

GROUP A:

1. How does your being a Christian influence your college experience? Give examples.
2. Have you made a difference in someone's life because of your faith? If so, how? What specific instances indicate this to you?
3. Do you feel that your faith has been tested more often in your away from home setting? Describe instances and tell how you have responded.

GROUP B:

1. During the last two years, who has had the greatest influence on you? To whom have you gone for advice? Who seems to "steer" you in the right direction, and "steer" you amiss? Give examples to illustrate your answers.
2. Have you ever fought with God over any issues that have puzzled you? What were these issues? What was the final outcome? How did you emerge from the conflict? Can you look back on that episode and see that it changed you in any way? Be specific.

Provide one letter of recommendation by an adult (such as teacher, work supervisor, guidance counselor, sports coach, band director, etc.). No parents or relatives please.

Application Rubric: Applications will be considered using a point system based on the following criteria.

Application content and neatness, Church involvement, Essays, Transcripts, Part-time/full-time student, Letter of Recommendation, and overall impression.
